But you choose to punish me. You choose to continue the abuse by using the exact same tactics [Park Manager] did at that picnic table.

And then you expelled me from the one thing I ever tried to join in my entire adult life.

And then you went silent.

At this point, I don't know if I'll sue you. I reached out to some pretty powerful attorneys. They didn't show enough interest. I paused to reassess.

I don't want to. I hope that's obvious.

But I won't let an institution reframe reality just because it's inconvenient for them.

You harmed me. You are harming me right now.
