Local Area Information

Reedsport is an outdoor lover's paradise. The Umpqua River is home to one of the largest recreational fishing ports on the Oregon Coast. In addition to fishing, locals and visitors enjoy hunting, hiking, riding ATVs on the dunes, beach combing, boating, bike riding, and much more. Just three miles east on Highway 38 is the famous Dean Creek Elk Viewing area currently sustaining hundreds of Oregon's Roosevelt Elk in their natural habitat with viewing stations and photo opportunities.

Park Description

William Tugman State Park is on the shore of Eel Lake, a short distance inland from the ocean and Oregon Dunes Recreation Area. Visitors to the park find good fishing at the lake and enjoy swimming, canoeing, sailing, and boating. This area is known for its spectacular wildlife viewing. Hikers of the park trails enjoy spotting osprey, eagles, and deer.

- Greeting Host: Sell firewood and provide reasonable assistance to park guests.
- Yurt Cleaner: Clean yurts and campsites, perform light landscape maintenance, and assist rangers with projects.
- Relief Greeting/Yurt Cleaner: Two days per week, sell firewood and provide reasonable assistance to park guests. Three days per week, clean yurts and campsites, perform light landscape maintenance, and assist rangers with projects.
