Narrative:

Oregon State Police (OSP) Major Crimes Section (MCS) received a request to perform a threat assessment on an individual who was terminated from the Oregon State Parks Department. The individual took issue with the termination and had been contacting the parks department frequently. Additionally, the individual was found to be posting some concerning things online. The parks department was concerned for potential further escalation from the individual.

OSP MCS Sergeant Sean Henderson assigned the case to me for further investigation. Sergeant Henderson also provided me with the original email received from the Oregon State Parks Department. I reviewed the email and learned that the individual was identified as Robert Samuel White (White) with a date of birth of 04-11-1977. What follows is the communication received from Oregon State Parks Department Emergency Manager Jamen Lee:

Email from Jamen Lee:

Fyi - sharing for situational awareness since he is now including the Governor as well as our Director.

Website author was dismissed from volunteering with OPRD on 3/25/25 and flagged as ineligible for future service.

Has continued to email the OPRD staff (listed on his website) and recently escalated to including a countdown to the one-year anniversary of his dismissal in his emails to OPRD's Deputy Director JR Collier.

We can discuss more details if need be after our check-in with involved staff today.

Jamen Lee

I reviewed the provided website created by White. White appeared to be disgruntled about being terminated from the Oregon Parks Department as a volunteer at Honeyman State Park. White had a timeline of events per his information. White also posted many videos of his conversations with the parks department employees regarding his termination.

White appeared to be upset and has continued updating the website and his perceived grievances for a year and as of 4-15-26 appears to continue to post and update the website. White does not appear to make any direct threats or does not have any apparent or obvious leakage towards violence or violent behavior.

While reviewing his original posts on his website to most recent ones there has been a clear and obvious change in attitude and demeanor. In an effort to interrupt, deescalate, and attempt to listen and understand White's grievance OSP Detective Jake Hyde and I responded to White's currently location. We learned that White was currently volunteering for the National Forest Service and was staying in his RV at a National Forest Service maintenance site off of Siltcoos Beach Access Road in Florence.

On March 14, 2026, at about 9:50am Detective Hyde and I met with National Forest Service Special Agent Matthew Oliver and attempted to contact White at his motorhome. White answered the door, and I identified myself and advised him I had my body worn camera activated. I asked White if I could speak with him and he responded and said "I'm listening" I attempted to tell White the reason for the contact and that we were just there to have a conversation with him. White immediately stated that he did not want to talk with us without an attorney. I again told White he was not in trouble, and he again responded that he did not want to talk with us without an attorney and shut the door. We then left the location. For exact details and statements please see attached BWC.

After leaving White's motorhome Special Agent Oliver attempted phone contact with White to again explain the reason for the contact. White did not want to listen to what Special Agent Oliver had to say and ultimately became frustrated and hung up on Special Agent Oliver.

Later Special Agent Oliver provided me with an emailed summary of his actions in regards to White. He also provided me with text messages that he had received from White. I added the documents received from Special Agent Oliver with this case file please see attached documents.

Ultimately White does not appear to be escalating on the pathway to violence. While concerning White's behavior, it does not appear to be an immediate threat additionally there is no evidence White has committed any crimes.
